## School Keep Clear

**NO STOPPING  
NO PARKING  
NO WAITING**

**Why do I have to leave it clear?**  
For safety - to ensure clear sight lines for both motorists and children, as well as for other road users, outside schools. They provide a clear area in which children and adults can cross more safely.

**Am I okay just to pick up on the zig-zag markings if I am only there for a second?**  
Under no circumstance should you stop on zig-zag markings at any time, even just for a second. A stationary car can prevent a driver seeing a child crossing the road.

**But it's raining, can I just drop off?**  
Don't be pressured by bad weather into parking on the Keep Clear zig-zags. Rule 238 of the Highway Code states: "You **MUST NOT** wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings when upright signs indicate a prohibition of stopping." Better a wet coat than parking illegally which could result in a fine.

**Keep the Zig-Zags clear- No excuses!**

## Important Message From RBWM

You may have seen the recent news coverage on the increase in measles outbreaks. Measles is a highly infectious disease, especially within schools, and can be very serious. NHS England has launched a national MMR catch-up campaign. Over the next few months, children aged 6 to 11 who are missing one or two doses of the MMR vaccine will be invited to contact their GP practice to check their immunisation history and book an appointment for the MMR vaccination. [Your local Children's Immunisation Team](#) will also be holding local community clinics for 6- to 11-year-olds.

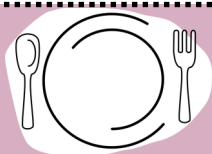
